Christian Broadcasting, Inc. owners and operators of KATB 89.3, KAFC 93.7, and KVNT 1020 AM in Anchorage and KJLP 88.9 in Palmer has acquired KJNP-TV Channel 4 in North Pole/Fairbanks Alaska.

Tom Steigleman, General Manager of Christian Broadcasting, Inc. said “We’re thankful for the opportunity and the trust Evangelistic Alaska Missionary Fellowship, Inc. presented to us. We’re looking forward to honoring the legacy of KJNP-TV while making some new programming available to the North Pole and Fairbanks area.”

Dick Olson, General Manager of Evangelistic Alaska Missionary Fellowship said “God is good, and as He has done before, He has provided a way for KJNP-TV to continue. We’re glad to see that KJNP-TV has returned to the air and we’re excited to see what Christian Broadcasting, Inc. has instore for North Pole and Fairbanks.”

KJNP-TV had been off the air for nearly a year due to multiple technical difficulties and was on the verge of having to surrender the license to the FCC. “We became involved with about a month to go before the license was going to have to be surrendered. Our team came up with a plan and we were able to return the station to the air and save it just days before the FCC deadline.” Steigleman said.

Television is not new for Christian Broadcasting, Inc. Steigleman is also the General Manager of KCFT Channel 35 in Anchorage, which is owned by Alaska Broadcast Television. “I’m excited about the opportunity we have to help Churches, ministries, and businesses reach viewers in the two largest cities in Alaska.” Steigleman said.
