Dear Mr. President:

The Board of Directors of the National Religious Broadcasters (NRB) recently adopted unanimously a resolution to pledge to pray for you and the members of Congress. Enclosed please find a copy of this Resolution.

Also, the Board passed a Resolution asking that you make a bold public statement against the international persecution of Christians, and to further enforce that position through your choice of Executive Branch appointments and through your foreign policy decisions.

Mr. President, legislation was introduced in the House by Representative Frank Wolf, H.R. 440, to create a special envoy position at the State Department to focus exclusively on the plight of religious minorities in the Middle East and South Central Asia. It is our hope that this legislation will be passed by the House and Senate and that when it arrives on your desk you will sign it.

Thank you for your attention to this critical matter.
