- WHEREAS** The National Religious Broadcasters was organized in 1944 for the primary purposes of gaining access to the electronic media, promoting excellence in Christian broadcasting and providing opportunities for broadcasters to enjoy Christian fellowship, and
- WHEREAS** The membership has grown from a very few to a historic high of more than 1,500 member organizations, representing millions of listeners, viewers and readers, and
- WHEREAS** The Association has become a highly respected, influential and beneficial organization for Christian broadcasters, and
- WHEREAS** Numerous qualified Christian broadcasters, including churches and other organizations, could benefit greatly from NRB but are not members of NRB, and
- WHEREAS** The need for NRB has never been greater, and
- WHEREAS** It is desirable to broaden the influence of the Association with additional membership of quality Christian broadcasters. Therefore, be it
- RESOLVED** That in order to better carry out our Christian mission, the members of NRB will work together in active recruitment to grow our membership by the year 2008 from the present number of more than 1,500 member organizations to 3,000 member organizations.
